White Wine by the glass **Bottle Price**

- 1. Gargenega Pino Grigio (1) £13.95**
Cortestrada, Italy, 2012

Intense straw colour and the amply fruity bouquet so typical of Pinot Grigio. Dry, soft and well-balanced palate.

- 2. Sauvignon Blanc (1) £14.50**
Volandes, Chile, 2012

A varietally beautiful wine with an enticing nose of ripe green fruit, a crisp refreshing acidity and an integrated palate of citrus fruit and gooseberries all leading into a long pleasant finish.

- 3. Chardonnay (2) £15.50**
Beyond the River, Australia, 2012

Notes of pear and green apple with a good balance and integration of oak. Not too heavy but a nicely rounded body and a clinging finish.

- 4. Chenin Blanc Wild Yeast (2) £17.50**
False Bay, South Africa, 2011

Long wild yeast ferment provides bready aromas and additional complexity to the wine. Dried herbaceous notes, including fennel, followed by a creamy lemon character.

- 5. Picpoul de Pinet (1) £18.50**
Duc de Morny, Languedoc, France, 2011

Floral and enticing on the nose, exuberantly fresh yet still fine and elegant, with a very long finish

- 6. Dart Valley Reserve (2) £19.95**
Sharpham, Totnes, Devon

This dry and ever popular wine has a light fresh character achieved by careful blending and partial ageing in American oak. Lovely fruit aromas with subtle, delicate flavours and a just off-dry style resulting in a wine ideal for drinking alone or with food.

7. Merlot (B) **£13.95** **Peregrino, Chile, 2011**

A silky, smooth, rich medium bodied Merlot full of warm berry fruits and ripe plum, with a velvety finish

8. Syrah © **£14.50** **Pasos de la Capula, Spain, 2012**

A juicy full red wine with rich black fruit, a generous mouthful of wild fruit combined with a smooth finish. It also shows a deep complexity and rounded tannins.

9. Zinfandel (B) **£15.50** **770Miles, California, 2011**

This Zinfandel from the Central Valley region of California has a full nose with a palate of red berries supported by light integrated tannins and a fresh finish

10. Bordeaux Superieur © **£17.50** **Tour de Perrigal, Bordeaux, 2010**

A Bordeaux superior showing great quality with full tannins which coat the mouth. It shows dark blackcurrants with vanilla nuance and a defined earthy edge, this wine will definitely develop.

11. Cabernet Sauvignon (C) **£18.50** **The Pugilist, Australia, 2011**

A stunning Cabernet from the Limestone Coast. This rich well rounded wine is oozing with blackcurrent cassis fruit. A dark soft finish just lingers on!

12. Malbec (C) **£19.95** **Nieto, Argentina, 2011**

Full bodied on the palate with rounded, ripe tannins and a long finish reminiscent of plums, damsons and figs

13. Zinfandel Rosé (3) **£14.50** **Wildwood, USA, 2011**

Mouth-watering summer berry flavours with a hint of candy create this perfectly balanced, easy drinking and refreshing rosé
